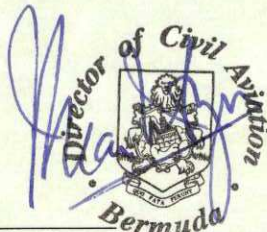
# Aircraft Maintenance Organisation Conditions

**M.C.M. MAINTENANCE CENTER MUNICH**, is hereby approved in accordance with the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2001 (AN(OT)O), as amended, and the Bermuda Airworthiness Requirements (BARs) as follows:

1. In accordance with AN(OT)O Article 12(8) (c) and BAR Number 17; to issue Certificates of Release to Service for the aircraft types listed on the Approval.
2. In accordance with AN(OT)O Article 10(3) (a) (iii) and BAR Number 19; to issue Certificates of Maintenance Review for the aircraft types listed on the Approval.
3. In accordance with AN(OT)O Article 134 and BAR Number 16 to furnish reports concerning:
  - (i) The issue of Certificates of Airworthiness for new aircraft.
  - (ii) The re-issue of Certificates of Airworthiness for aircraft.
  - (iii) The issue of Certificates of Airworthiness for Export.
  - (iv) The issue of Permits to Fly.
4. In accordance with AN(OT)O Article 134 as being competent to furnish reports concerning the acceptability of components, goods and services provided for Bermuda registered aircraft from, appropriately approved EASA, JAA, FAA, or TC sources, prior to issuing Certificates of Release to Service for Bermuda registered aircraft.

This Approval is limited to the aircraft types listed on the approval and the conditions of the NAA Approval Reference No. DE.145.0125 FOR M.C.M. MAINTENANCE CENTER - MUNICH upon which the Bermuda Approval is based. Any reduction to the NAA Approval automatically reduces Bermuda Approval Reference No. BDA/AMO/290.
